 - Recurring theme was housing and housing supports
- Alignment with the Community Health Improvement Plan and the State Health Improvement Plan
- Impacts of COVID-19 on housing status
 - Rent moratorium
 - Wildfire impact on affordable housing in Lincoln County

Proposed Project

Coordinated Regional Housing Effort

- Strategy: Bring together a coordinated group across the region
- Process Goal: Hire coordinator for the regional project that IHN-CCO manages and supports
- Process Goal: Create housing dashboard by leveraging current data/databases
 - Unite Us
 - ShelterWare
 - Electronic Health Records
 - IHN-CCO Claims Data
 - From organizations such as HOPE (Housing, Opportunity, Planning and Equity), Creating Housing Coalition, HEART (The Homeless Enrichment and Rehabilitation Team), Community Services Consortium, and more
- Process Goal: Create housing coalition to ensure a coordinated regional effort that addresses high needs and gap areas

Proposed Project

Proposed Measurable Outcomes

- Increase the percentage of IHN-CCO Members who have safe, accessible, affordable housing (CAC CHIP SD1*)
 - Number of homeless persons
 - Number of homeless students
- Review projected numbers for homelessness due to COVID-19 and reduce impact
- Transitional housing including stable housing upon discharge from hospital, emergency room visit, or incarceration
- Evictions prevention and reduction
- Integration of Traditional Health Workers in the housing sector
