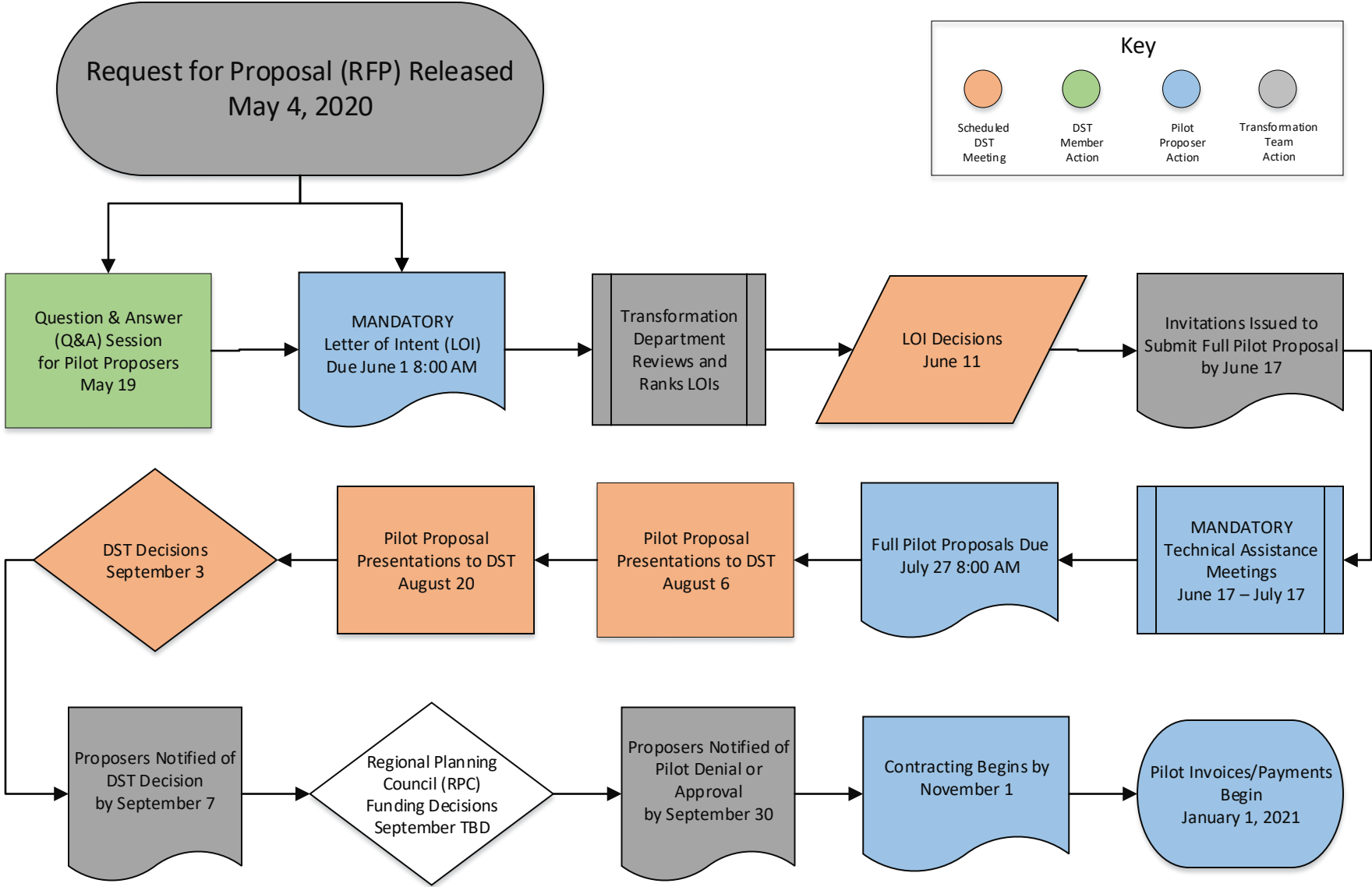

- The COVID-19 Community Support Program funded by IHN-CCO and managed by the Transformation Department is going well. Eight community-based organizations are currently in contract and receiving funds, while there are two more pending contract.

# IHN-CCO DST Pilot Extension Request: Integrated Foster Child Wellbeing

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**Original Start Date:** 1/1/2019

**Original End Date:** 12/31/2020

**Months Requested:** 12

**New End Date:** 12/31/2021

**Brief Summary:** The purpose of this pilot is to develop a model of care to achieve the mission of the program of coordinating care for high-need foster children. Key components are coordinating services, intensive care coordination, and establishing sustainability. Pilot goals include:

- Provide timely comprehensive medical, dental, mental health and developmental/educational assessments for all children entering foster care.
- Provide support to the youth in foster care and the foster families to optimize the placement.
- Support families transitioning to reunification and youth transitioning out of care.

**A. What is the reason for a time extension?**

- Due to the coronavirus pandemic, some of our activities have had to be postponed (conferences, larger group meetings, etc).

**B. If this request is not granted, will any activities or outcomes from the original proposal not be possible?**

- The following may not be possible without the extension: parenting support system, additional training for staff, expansion/ development of Lincoln county program.

**C. If this request is granted, are there new activities or outcomes that will be possible?**

We are planning a Youth and Children in Foster Care Workgroup (subgroup of the System of Care) to develop a community wide shared vision for children in foster care and develop measurable outcomes.
