Brief Summary:

A. What is the reason for a time extension?

The above referenced award has been greatly impacted by COVID-19. The project has been on hold since March 31, 2020 due to the pandemic. In April, May and June we were on hold because of institutional travel and research restrictions. Additionally, we were under a “Shelter In Place” mandate by Oregon Governor, Kate Brown. While OSU is now allowing us to safely re-start research activities, both of our partners at Linn County Public Health, as well as our own team members, are intensively immersed in COVID-19 response activities that preclude us from making significant progress on Linn WINS at this time. We are in regular contact with InterCommunity Health Plans about the project “hold” and expect to begin work again in Fall 2020. We are therefore requesting a one-year No Cost Extension; which should offer us ample time to meet the project goals. In addition to requesting an extension through December 31, 2021, we are also requesting a revised Invoice/Payment Schedule. Invoices will be submitted monthly September 2020 through December 2020.

B. If this request is not granted, will any activities or outcomes from the original proposal not be possible?

- We will not be able to meet all of the outcomes if the No Cost Extension is not granted. To date, only the following has been completed:
- Engage IHN-CCO member shoppers to learn about member needs and behaviors in the retail space
 - i. Identify convenience stores in Linn County proximate to highest number of IHN-CCO members
 - 1. List of top twenty stores that are closest to the largest amount of members

C. If this request is granted, are there new activities or outcomes that will be possible?

- No, the project will move forward as originally proposed.
