- The Regional Planning Council (RPC) approved all DST pilots to move forward. See summaries on pages 8-12 of the packet.

Workgroup Updates

Health Equity: Alicia Bublitz

- Brink Communications was engaged to create messaging for the Health Equity Workgroup. See pages 13-15 in the packet.
- The target audience is very broad and includes IHN-CCO leadership, community-based organizations, providers, and more.
- The goal was to provide consistent messaging coming from the needs of the community.
- Transformation will send the editable file, feel free to use and/or disseminate widely.

Social Determinants of Health: Britny Chandler

- The Social Determinants of Health Workgroup (SDoH) is just beginning work on food security. This starts with a needs assessment survey of partners. See packet pages 16-18.
- Next steps will be to synthesize the information and use it as a foundation for recommendations to IHN-CCO and the community.
- Transformation will send the survey to the DST.

Traditional Health Worker: Charissa Young-White

- Developing a THW Workgroup Onboarding Packet with the following topics:
 - THW overview: who are THWs.
 - What kinds of THWs are there.
 - Vision and goals.
 - Partners, history, and details of THW workgroup.
 - Future goals and strategies.
- Currently working on sustainability of the Traditional Health Worker Hub as well as traditional health workers (THWs) in general.
- The Oregon Health Authority (OHA) just released some guidance on billing that will help all the CCOs understand their roles moving forward.
 - It has been a challenging for all CCOs in Oregon to understand the expectations, but the hope is more and more guidance coming forward in the next few months.

- Aligning with the IHN-CCO CHIP/CHA (Community Health Improvement Plan/Community Health Assessment) and county CHIPs as well as the hospital community benefit plans.
- Measuring whether or not the efforts have made a difference in healthcare in the region.
 - Have a group or panel to evaluate pilots.
 - Collect meaningful data that is aligned among the pilots.
 - Utilize current resources such as Oregon State University (OSU) to reliably and responsibility report on this information.
 - Assess whether the pilot achieved their goals or does what the CHIP or CHA indicates needs to be done.
 - How many pilots were sustained or operationalized and what does this mean? Most pilots are sustained in some way, but this does not include replication and spread across regions.
 - Suggestion to look at this in more depth.
 - Handling the process of data collection and measurement is a priority for the DST.
- Sustainability would be better to be more defined.
- Behavioral health could be the biggest priority in 2021.
- Involving and engaging other partners, called out example is ensuring the counties are aware of projects as they could should be collaborating.
- The DST could focus on the impacts of COVID:
 - Schools
 - Substance abuse
 - Domestic abuse
 - Child abuse
 - Social isolation
- Parent Teacher Associations (PTAs) could have good insight into communities.
- The DST has been a place for the strategies for people that have voices that are not always heard. Data may not have been historically collected on these groups or that data cannot capture.
 - Keeping that openness in the work the DST does is important; it is a platform where those who do not have another outlet can use their voice and get funded.

Wrap-Up/Announcements

- Flyers and information will be sent out in the DST follow up email tomorrow.
- The next meeting is October 15, 2020.
- Trillium Child and Family Services:
 - Migrating to a new building and has asked OHA for startup dollars to update/renovate the empty building. This will more than double the capacity for residential psychiatric treatment beds for children aged 5-11 in Oregon.
 - Increased demand for psychiatric day treatment due to COVID-19.
