Healthier Together Oregon provides a common vision and shared priorities for how to improve health for people in our state. Some of the strategies are already in progress. CCOs and Healthier Together Oregon

Requirement:

- CCO Community Health Improvement Plans (CHPs) submitted on or after 2020 must include at least two Healthier Together Oregon priorities and strategies.

Opportunities for alignment:

- Many existing CHP and HTO health priority areas already in alignment
- Increased focus on SDOH-E programs and investments
- Ability to utilize Health-Related Services (HRS) and SHARE initiative to fund CHP implementation in collaboration with CHP partners.

CHP & SHIP Alignment Example

EOCCO CHP 2019 - 2024

- **Priority Area:** Early Childhood Toxic Stress and Trauma
- **Objective #1:** Increase community awareness.
- **Strategy:** Build community awareness about environmental conditions that promote healthy brain development in the early years of life (0 – 5).

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- **Priority Area:** Adversity, Trauma, and Toxic Stress
- **Implementation Area:** Healthy Communities
- **Strategy:** Develop community awareness of toxic stress, its impact on health and the importance of protective factors

CHP & SHIP Alignment Example

Advanced Health Curry CHIP 2019

- **Focus Area:** Communities and Families
- **Strategy Priority Area:** Youth and Seniors
- **Strategy:** Increase supports for seniors including programs that address social isolation.

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- **Priority Area:** Behavioral Health
- **Implementation Area:** Healthy Communities
- **Strategy:** Expand programs that address loneliness and increase social connection in older adults.
