A HEALTHY SMILE FOR YOUR CHILD

The normal groove of a tooth is too small and deep for a toothbrush to clean well.

When our teeth are not cleaned well germs build up and cause tooth decay (cavity). A cavity can cause your child pain, leading to missed school days, costly dental treatment, and possible tooth loss.

A sealant is a thin plastic that flows down into the tooth's grooves making a smooth surface that can be cleaned easily with a toothbrush.

Along with sealants, brushing and flossing every day can help prevent cavities.
